A Message from Rayburn Music's Ronni Ginott..

"In addition to my role as the Northeast Regional Operations Manager for Rayburn Music, I have an extremely important job. I am a single father of four wonderful children. This certainly can be a daily challenge, but I wouldn't trade being a father for anything. The one additional challenge in life is the fact that my 8 year old son Joshua is non-verbal autistic. He is a very special child in many ways, but also creates many additional obstacles. While other 8 year olds can tell you when they are tired, sick, or hungry, Joshua struggles with the words and signs to communicate his wants and needs. Sometimes, his frustration turns to anger because he just wants you to know what it is that he is trying to say. His three siblings (12 year old brother, 9 year old sister, and 6 year old brother) are truly amazing in how they deal with him on a daily basis. It's touching to watch as a 12 year old child protects his little brother in a way that very few will ever know. The compassion and caring is something that would bring a tear to your eye.

The reason that I am sharing my personal story is so that I may share my vision and Rayburn's vision for helping provide Music Education for all children. As our company moves into 2010 and beyond, we will be focused and driven to help schools and towns across the Northeast to help provide additional Music Education. We will be working to develop affordable private lesson programs, in school seminars and assemblies, workshops for Music Educators, and fund-raising programs. In addition, we will begin to bring our Music Education workshops into Special Needs programs in the schools and towns where we do business. I see the benefits of Music for a child with Special Needs, and will be working to see this initiative through."
